



The Minaputa Dojo Logo/Badge

Wearing the dojo badge is not compulsory, indeed wearing the society badge is preferred if it comes down to a choice of one over the other.

If they choose to, the jujutsuan should wear this badge on the left sleeve at the shoulder.

The new logo consists of a stylised Yin/Yang symbol, the bottom half has the *Hyouka Kamon* *Panther Blossom Crest* 豹花家紋 embedded to show our connection to the *Kokusai Jujutsu Kenkyukai International Jujutsu Research Society* 國際柔術研究会
